

Man killed in apparent home invasion

Woman injured in Mooresville shooting; no suspects

A Mooresville man was shot to death early Tuesday morning during an apparent home invasion, authorities said.

Matthew Ryan Stewart, 31, died and his wife, Angela, was also shot, but her injuries are not believed to be life-threatening, said Mooresville Police

Chief Carl Robbins.

Robbins said Angela Stewart was shot in the arm.

The shooting happened at 158 Shephard Hill Drive, which is in a subdivision off Shinnville Road and U.S. Highway 21, just north of the N.C. 115/U.S. 21 split.

The MPD received a 911 call at 12:15 a.m. from Angela Stewart, who said

someone entered her home and started firing a gun.

When officers arrived, they found Angela Stewart inside a neighbor's house.

Officers went inside the couple's home and found the husband had been shot to death.

Angela Stewart told police that she and her husband were in bed when a man entered the room and started firing.

As of Tuesday afternoon, police said they did not have any suspects in

the fatal shooting.

Robbins said Angela Stewart was not able to provide a description of the suspect.

"The SBI is helping us, and all of our detectives are out interviewing people," Robbins said. "This is a real fluid, evolving situation."
